

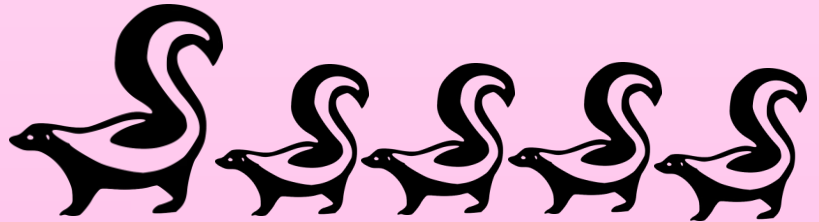
Animal Highlight:

Did you know?

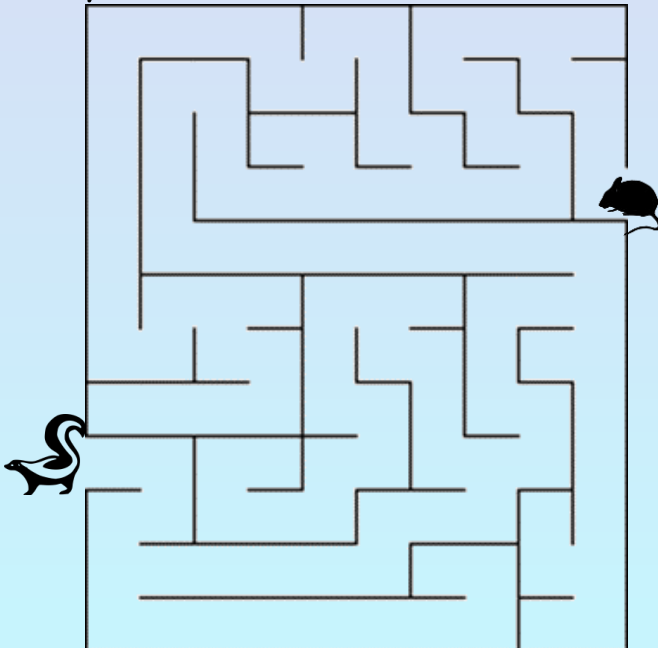
Skunks, like Meadow, live among us here in Indiana! They prefer to live in ample habitats where they can easily find food and raise their young.
